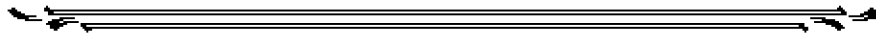

Educational Opportunities for Fall

In an attempt to respond to our newly adopted mission plan, the Education Ministry Area team is busy identifying leaders, teachers, advisors and materials for this fall. There are still leadership needs that we have to address. Since our new educator, Angie Fansler, does not begin until **September 1st**, we need to address these leadership issues immediately.

Thank you to all who responded to our Sunday morning leadership needs.

September begins our second year of B.A.M. (Bible and Me) workshop rotation program. Leadership has been identified and rooms are ready to go. The rest of the Sunday morning classes have identified leadership.



Wednesday nights will take a slightly different approach this fall. We are attempting to target the needs of families with infants through 8th grade. In order to encourage parents with small children, we are attempting to offer child care for one hour on Wednesday evening while parents are taking classes on Marriage and Parenting. Therefore, we need 4 people (preferably older adults) who can work in two person teams in Nursery and Pre-school.

Since Wednesday night is the evening for fellowship for **Pioneers (6-8th graders)**, we **still need one more leader for the month of March** to work with Don Gale. In an effort to develop a hand bell choir that can play a broader range of music, Worship Ministry Area has created a High School/Adult hand bell choir that meets on Wednesday nights with Ken Young.

The entire Wednesday evening is more family friendly. It offers a simple meal, fellowship, education, and music for the entire family on a tighter schedule. We also want to attract families within the surrounding community to participate. Therefore, we need all hands on deck.
